



Summer Program Scholarship Information Sheet

The Riverview High School Kiltie Band Boosters organization is pleased to offer scholarship assistance to members of the Kiltie Band who are planning to attend a summer program. Summer Program Scholarships are awarded to help in the growth of students' musical, dance, and leadership abilities as well as to help to build the Kiltie Band program. The application is for individual scholarships, and funds are awarded to the following guidelines:

Who Can Apply

All Riverview High School Kiltie Band members who are currently enrolled in the band program and in good standing are eligible for the scholarship.

How To Apply

Submit the completed application to your Band Director by March 1. Applications submitted after March 1 will not be accepted for consideration.

The application must be filled out completely and signed by a parent/guardian to be eligible for scholarship consideration. PARENTS - Please ensure that all information on the application is accurate and complete before submission.

The exact name of the summer program must be properly identified on the application, as the scholarship checks are sent directly to the institution. Proof of registration for the summer program will be required prior to scholarship disbursement. Proof of registration must include the full contact information for the program including the mailing address, email address, and telephone number. The deadline for this information will be noted in the award letter.

Scholarship Distribution

Scholarship awards are 50% of the summer program cost, before any discounts, up to a maximum of \$250. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come first-serve basis until the annual Summer Program Scholarship Fund is depleted. It is advisable to apply for the scholarship as early as possible. Note: Some summer programs offer early registration discounts and some offer different levels of matching funding for booster scholarships. These discounts are applied after the Summer Program Scholarship is applied and as such may dramatically reduce the final cost to the student.

All scholarship recipients are required to submit a Thank-You letter to the Kiltie Band Boosters upon receipt of the award letter. Scholarship funding checks will not be submitted to the summer programs until the Thank-You letter is received.

Cancellation Policy

Should the student elect not to attend the summer program, it is the parent's or guardian's responsibility to contact the program administration and the Kiltie Band Booster Treasurer in a timely manner to have a refund issued by the program and the scholarship funds returned to the Booster scholarship fund. If a refund cannot be issued by the summer program for any reason, including a no-show cancellation that was made too late, it will be the parent's or guardian's responsibility to reimburse the Kiltie Band Boosters for the full scholarship amount. Should a student not attend a summer program due to their registered program being cancelled, it will be the parent's or guardian's responsibility to obtain a refund from the program administration and return the funds to the Kiltie Band Booster Treasurer.

Publicity

All scholarship recipients will be asked to provide a brief 1-2 paragraph letter describing their summer program experience. This helps to increase awareness of the scholarship funding for future Kilties and is an important part of the scholarship program.
